



## Frequently Asked Questions

**Question:** Is there a deposit required for your service and if so, how much?

**Answer:** Yes, half price of the cost of your service.

**Question:** How long does it take to receive my video?

**Answer:** Up to four weeks but in most cases, sooner.

**Question:** How many weddings have you done? How many years have you been videotaping weddings?

**Answer:** *Re-Co Productions* has satisfied over 1000 clients since 1994.

**Question:** In the church, how close to us will you have to be with the camera in order for me to be able to hear my vows clearly on my video?

**Answer:** *Re-Co Productions* uses an interference-free wireless microphone on our camera. We can get close-ups from as far away as 50 feet.

**Question:** How will my finished *DVDs* differ from the unedited tape? Is there a two-hour limit on my finished video?

**Answer:** At *Re-Co Productions* we remove only the unpresentable footage, add titling, use special effects, and mix in the songs of your choice. We never limit the amount of digital videotape we use. The more partying you do, the longer your video is!

**Question:** Does your camera have any kind of red light on it? What kind of video camera do you use? Is it a one-chip camera?

**Answer:** No. Our cameras have no annoying red lights at all. *Re-Co* is always discreet; using *only* 3-chip broadcast cameras known for excellence in low-light conditions.

**Question:** Can I get a DVD of weddings you've done to take home and see on my own TV?

**Answer:** Yes. *We* want you to see our wedding videos, not on expensive studio monitors, but on your TV at home. This is where you'll be watching your wedding video once you're married. Before hiring any videographer compare the quality of the finished videos on your TV at home. Compare apples to apples.
